Guidelines for Photo Submission

Each Volunteer will be listed with a brief overview and photo of his or her contributions to your organization in the program book.

Suggestions for the program book photo:
The photo must be a head shot.

The photo can be black and white or color, but contrast is important.

Do not submit a photo from another publication.

During the Celebration, we would like to project a candid photo of each honoree on a large screen. With your cooperation, we can make it memorable.

Suggestions for the PowerPoint presentation photo:
Select a candid photo of your honoree.

Your honoree should be shown participating in their volunteer activity if at all possible.

Other people may be in the photo, but your honoree should be the main focus. (Please do not use a group posed shot.)

If a candid shot is not available, the head shot can be used for both purposes.
